How can I help?

Host Family

Families who take children into their homes for a night to a fortnight, giving struggling parents time to deal with pressing issues, have hospital treatment, or a respite break.



Family Friend

People who get alongside parents and children to befriend, mentor and support, providing companionship and friendship to those who are isolated or suffering.

Resource Friend

Supporters who are able to provide useful items such as a cot or children's clothing, or have helpful skills such as cooking or gardening.



Event Attendants

We're looking for men 18 years old and older to serve as paid event attendants to monitor third-party events (such as the soccer league) at Wells Street.

Responsibilities include unlocking & securing the building, encouraging event participants to remain in designated areas, and being a liaison between church administration and event participants.



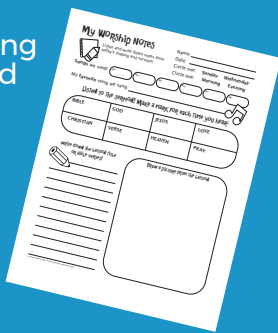

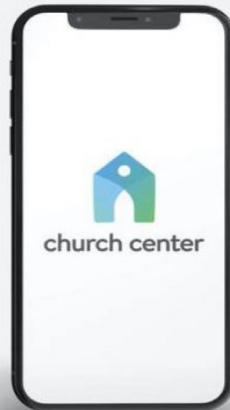
