IMMANUEL'S CHILD

This year we are again partnering with SGA's Immanuel's Child outreach in Russia and the surrounding countries.

Because of the war, more children and families are expected to come to these outreaches than ever before.

The churches expect at least 60,000 children — up 10,000 from last year including in Poland where there are 5 million refugees from Ukraine.

HOW CAN YOU HELP

Pick up a star hanging on the Christmas tree in the Welcome Gym, fill out the information, and return the Russian side of the star with a \$25 gift.

You keep the English side and pray for whoever receives the other half of the star.


