## What should I expect in class?



The kids at **Bloomington Elementary** sent us a pile of thanks after receiving their new Bloomington Chiefs spirit-wear.

## Redefining Success

Unmet expectations. We've all experienced them. A job that doesn't match what we had hoped for when hired. A carefully planned vacation that has to be canceled. A long-term relationship ends abruptly. We wonder if we did enough. We wonder what we did wrong. We wonder why life can be so messy.

When we enter into the ministry of hospitality, it can be easy to set our sights on our own definitions of success, only to have those expectations dashed by a different reality. When reality doesn't align with our expectations, the easiest response is often frustration, doubt, or even defeat.

But what if we redefined success? What if success was less about results and more about simply showing up? John 1:14 tells us that "The Word became flesh and blood, and moved into the neighborhood" (MSG). The incarnation of Jesus as a person tells us that presence matters to the God of the universe. The world often models that success equals results - we must produce. Jesus simply asks that we show up in obedience and be with.

Volunteer family coaches Jeanne and Mike Belth agree.

"We need to define success as when we are faithful to do what we ought to do," says Mike. "We have to recognize that many times, things aren't going to turn out the way we want, but... we can actually succeed every time if we go out and serve the way the Lord would have us serve, and then leave it to God to do the work."

Because Jesus moved into hard, complicated places, Christ followers are compelled to do

the same. We can move into messy situations, because that is what has been done for us. We don't have all of the answers, but we can walk alongside those around us trusting that God is always moving.

"I've got to remember that it's God doing the work," Jeanne says. "He's not going to mess things up. I may, but he won't." ■



# WAR IN UKRAINE



## Missions Minute

# Slavic Gospel Association | SGA

*Matthew 24:14 "And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations and then the end will come."*



The mission committee at Headwaters church had the privilege to speak with **Eric Mock** (left), the Vice President of Ministry Operations, from SGA. He will be going to Poland March 30 to visit 20 churches in 5 days. These churches are helping 1000 refugees a day by allowing them to wash clothes, have a hot shower and a meal before they continue on the find a place to live. The first refugees were mostly traveling to stay with relatives. Now the people have no place to go. More and more people are going into Russia.

We need to remember that Putin's plans do not represent the Russian people. Many of the pastors in Russia are Ukrainian (including our four missionaries to Russia). They are broken hearted at what is going on.

SGA is providing financial aid in 22 regions of Ukraine, mostly in the east and central part of the country. Eighty percent of SGA's aid is going toward food and medications. The rest is for blankets and gasoline as people are driving daily to the border to help people escape. They are faithfully sharing the Gospel while meeting physical needs

Pray for the faithful believers like Andrei who minister to the needs of others while they too suffer under this relentless invasion. ■


