PRAYER WALK

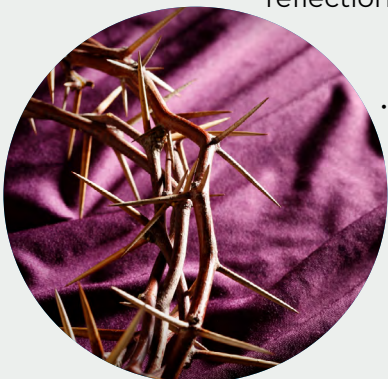

Engage all your senses as you contemplate the week of Jesus' betrayal, conviction, death, and resurrection. This Scripture-led walk is designed to help you reflect in a unique and meaningful way. Visit seven different reflections and engage in Scripture readings, journaling, prayer, and contemplation as you use the Prayer Walk guide. You determine the pace at which you complete the walk.

Children are welcome and will receive a special Prayer Walk guide to use. While children are welcome anytime, you may want to take advantage of Wednesday evening and visit the Prayer Walk during the regular Awana timeslot (Awana and Wednesday night activities are not meeting to allow people this time to participate).

Here is some helpful information:

- Park in the Wells Street lot and enter Door #4.
- Stop by the staffed Welcome Table which is located just inside the door on your left. Pick up your Prayer Walk/Children's Prayer Walk guide, pens, and crayons for kids.
- Head down the children's hallway and reflect on the posted, six statements of Jesus as you prepare to begin the walk.
- Head to the stairs and go up to the third floor to begin the walk. (Note: if you need to use an elevator, there is one halfway down the children's hallway).
- The walk begins in Room 310. You will then head to Room 306, followed by Room 304 and then across the walkway and down the stairs as you make your way to the Chapel for the last four reflections. Directional signs will be posted. Exit the back of the Chapel as you complete the walk, returning any pens/crayons to the container provided and exit Door #4.
- You may want to plan for a minimum of 10-15 minutes per interaction. Again, you will work through the guide at your own pace.
- Please help us maintain a contemplative environment by being mindful of talking volume in rooms and hallways as you participate in the walk.
