






ELDER CANDIDATES TESTIMONIES

TOM CLOTHIER



"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." (Ephesians 2:8–10)

"Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost, but now am found. Was blind, but now I see." – John Newton

What the Apostle Paul expressed to the Ephesian believers in Christ, and John Newton wrote as a personal testimony, God has used to remind me as to who is truly responsible for my salvation. I was born and raised in Detroit, MI. My parents were religious, but remained unconverted to the biblical gospel until just prior to their deaths. My family and I attended church throughout my childhood. However, I remained an unconverted sinner. I was spiritually dead in my trespasses and sin (Eph. 2:1-3).

The Lord converted me in October of 1974 when I was nineteen. This occurred through the sowing of many seeds of the Gospel by faithful co-workers at jobs I held throughout high school and upon entering college (I Corinthians 3:5-9).

I received Jesus Christ as my Savior and Lord following the preaching of the Gospel in a Sunday evening worship service at a church I recently began attending. During the message, the pastor stated, "If any of you were to die tonight, where would you spend eternity?" Following years of hearing the truth of Jesus Christ's virgin birth, sinless life, substitutionary death on the cross, and bodily resurrection on behalf of sinners like me, it was at that moment the Holy Spirit convicted me of my sinfulness and brought to me a realization of the condemned condition of my soul.

It was later that evening, when alone in my bedroom of my parent's home, I literally knelt down beside my bed, repented of my sin and received Jesus Christ as my Savior and Lord (John 1:12-13).

The Holy Spirit regenerated my soul enabling me to believe the truth of the Gospel (John 3:1-8; Titus 3:1-5), God gave me new, spiritual life in Christ (Ephesians 2:4-5). He saved me from the penalty, power, and eventual presence of sin by grace alone, through God-given faith alone in the person and work of Jesus Christ alone (John 1:1-18; Rom. 3:21-26; Ephesians 2:8-9).

Following my conversion, I became aware that this was part of God's eternal plan before the foundation of the world (Ephesians 1:3-4). I am a child of God.


