


AUG 27 | 12:30 PM



CLASS OPTIONS

ABIDE: A STUDY OF 1, 2, & 3 JOHN [WOMEN'S STUDY]

Teacher: Christine Overholt



Description: Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you (1 John 2:24)... How can we hold onto assurance of our faith? How can we discern the truth from a lie? How can we know God loves us? In these three short letters, the apostle John reminds an early church facing division, deception, and doubt to hold fast to what they know and to live like they believe it. And he reminds us, as well. In this 10-session Bible study on the letters of 1, 2, and 3, John, Jen Wilkin helps you see how two thousand years later, his words call to Christians in similar challenges to recall a great salvation and to abide in the truth.

SOUL CARE & DISCIPLESHIP FUNDAMENTALS CLASS

Teacher: Scott Meinema

Description: This Fundamentals course serves as an introductory exploration of Biblical Soul Care, encompassing both its theological foundations and practical applications. The course consists of 35 online lectures, specifically designed to provide participants with an overview of how the scriptures provide both hope and help with the issues of life. To ensure an engaging learning experience, the course is structured in a way that allows each participant to listen to three lectures per week at their own pace. Following this, participants are expected to attend the weekly class session, which offers an opportunity for interaction and discussion centered around the lecture content. Each participant is provided with a 100+ page notebook, weekly access to online lectures, and opportunities in class to interact with the content, ask questions, and dig deeper into what they are learning. Scheduled every Wednesday from 6:30-8pm, the course commences on August 23.

Elder Confirmation

Last Sunday the Headwaters elders prayed for two new additions to the elder board, Tom Clothier and Andy Opliger. We stopped in the middle of our Sunday worship to highlight and pray for these two men for a few reasons.

First, we are an elder led church and transparency related to that leadership is important. As much as our elders lead from a disposition of humility, it is also important that they are known and accessible to the church family.

Second, we wanted to highlight the congregation's role in confirming Tom and Andy. They were not elected in a back room or snuck into leadership. Rather, our current elders nominated these men as godly and qualified potential leaders of the church and, after fielding questions in a variety of formats, our congregation confirmed their nomination. Third, we wanted to prayerfully recognize that all leadership within the church is dependent on God's guidance. Prayer is a tangible recognition of relying on God and a proper entry point for our two new elders.
